



Adverbs tell more about a verb.

Some adverbs show **when** or **where**.

Examples:

Aon studied for his test yesterday. (when)

Tucker is cleaning his room right now. (when)

Triniti carried her toys upstairs. (where)

Jared is playing outside. (where)

Soon we will go to recess. (when)

I will never leave my room. (when)

Blake's toys are everywhere. (where)

I live here in town. (where)
