



Verbs that end with **-s** are present tense verbs, they tell about  
**now**: Chris **makes** brownies.

Verbs that tell about the past (have already happened) end with  
**-ed**: Yesterday Chris **baked** brownies.

Verbs that tell about the future begin with **will**:  
Tomorrow Chris **will** bake brownies.

**Examples**:

**Past**

raised

danced

skipped

**Present**

raises

dances

skips

**Future**

will raise

will dance

will skip
